

## Rules of Participation

During a period of THREE DAYS, children will participate in Four different activities—Poetry Recitation / Short Story Narration / Book Review & Discussion / Inter-School Competitions.

- The details of all participants should be filled in Block Letters.
- Phone & WhatsApp numbers and E-mail IDs are important, so that they can receive update with respect to date & time.
- DATE & TIME of participation will be shared after the Submission Deadline is over i.e., **8 March, 2023**.
- The sooner we receive the completed forms and photos, the easier it will be to add the participants' photographs on banners and promotional materials with our eminent panel.

### 1. Open Mic Readings

1. This includes ORIGINAL poetry recitation; short, micro or flash fiction story narration. Paper reading is allowed. Maximum time allowed is only 5 mins.
2. Reading can be in Hindi/English/Local Dialect.
3. Children/Young readers who wish to review books have to contact us immediately so that we can give them books to read. Books include short stories in Hindi and English, English novels and Hindi poetry. The Book Discussion Panel will constitute of 6 participants each - the author, the moderator and four students. In 3 days, 9 books will be reviewed by 36 children.
4. For Book Review/Panel Discussion, the child has to read the book, write a review based on her/his understanding of the book, and prepare questions for the author. Each participant will get 5 mins to read her/his review. These will be engaging & interactive sessions.

### 2. Inter-School Competitions

Reporting time for all participants is 9.00 am on the day of the event for prior registration. We begin sharp at 9.30 am.

1. **Topics for Declamation are shared.** Children will be given 3 to 4 min only for narration. No Paper Reading Allowed. However, they can refer to their notes. Marks will be awarded on Content, Creativity, & Oratory Skills. Jury will keep the age factor in mind based on participation level for under-18 participants. Languages - Hindi and English only.
2. **Vocabulary Skills:** This will be in TWO PARTS: A written paper text and a quiz format to engage you in a Literary Fest. Mode: English & Hindi both.
3. **Slogan Writing / Poster Making / Bookmark Making**
  - Sheets will be provided by our TEAM.
  - A3 SHEETS for Slogan Writing & Poster Making;
  - 2 x 5 inch cut-outs for Book Marks.
  - Children will bring their own art supply—colour pencils, crayons, sketch & gel pens. No Paints Allowed.
