One Newborn Every 9 Hours: NAS-108 Ambulances Deliver Over 3,000 Newborns in Himachal Pradesh

The NAS-108 Ambulance Service, operated by Medswan Foundation in partnership with the Government of Himachal Pradesh and the National Health Mission (NHM), has reached a remarkable milestone—successfully assisting in over 3,060 safe deliveries inside ambulances or at emergency scenes since its inception on January 15, 2022. This milestone underscores the service's unwavering commitment to strengthening maternal and neonatal healthcare across the state.

Since it commenced its operations on 15th January 2022, the NAS-108 ambulance service has responded to over 4.27 lakhs emergencies, including around 78,000 pregnancy-related cases, navigating the tough Himalayan terrain to deliver timely medical care. With an average of one newborn welcomed every 9 hours, the service has emerged as a lifeline for expectant mothers, particularly in remote and underserved regions where healthcare access is limited.

The NAS-108 Ambulance Service has played a transformative role in reducing maternal and neonatal mortality rates, aligning with State's broader health goals. Equipped with skilled Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs), ambulance pilots, and essential Delivery kits, the service ensures safe deliveries even in most challenging situations. In many cases, when mothers in labor were referred to higher medical facilities due to complications, deliveries occurred en route—thanks to the expertise of 108 Ambulance team who handled these tough situations effectively.

This seamless blend of pre-hospital obstetric care and institutional healthcare has averted life-threatening complications. By bridging critical gaps in emergency response, NAS-108 has significantly bolstered Himachal Pradesh's health indices, setting a benchmark for emergency medical services nationwide. Himachal Pradesh's mountainous topography and scattered settlements often poses significant barriers to healthcare access. The NAS-108 Ambulance Service has turned this challenge into an opportunity and has emerged as the backbone of emergency healthcare infrastructure, ensuring 24x7 service across the State, even in the most remote regions. This achievement is a testament to the vision of the Government of Himachal Pradesh, the dedication of NHM, and the operational excellence of Medswan Foundation.

Beyond numbers, every delivery assisted by NAS-108 tells a story of hope and joy—bringing smiles to thousands of families. The service's trained staff and robust emergency response system have redefined pre-hospital care, proving that timely intervention can make all the difference. This milestone of over 3,000 deliveries is not just a number—it's a reflection of the trust placed in NAS-108 by the people of Himachal Pradesh and a step towards a healthier, stronger state.
